1 pleated skirt - pleats should be width 4cm, loops on skirt band, pleats facing left. Use 20cm zip for opening (left side). Skirts should fall 3" below the knee or mid- calf (see picture below)

1 school tie to be worn neatly tied at all times.

Plain white shoes and socks, plain (no holes or studs) white belt (4cm wide).

NB: Please pay particular attention to the exact shade of the swatches attached. No colour variation will be allowed.

ENTRY AND EXIT PROCEDURES
