# ONLINE EDUCATION GUIDELINES

- ▶ Log in for scheduled classes on time
- ▶ Student must use their full name when signing into classroom
- ▶ Be respectful to teachers and classmates



# ONLINE EDUCATION GUIDELINES

- Be participative
- When you have an inquiry or remark, utilize the “Raise your Hand” button
- Students must turn on/off their audio/video only on the request of the teacher
- Use the chat responsibly and stay on topic.
- Before posting a question make sure that the said question hasn’t already been asked
- Don’t type in ALL CAPS! It may come across as if you’re screaming

# ONLINE EDUCATION GUIDELINES

- Use proper writing style - run a spelling/grammar check before posting
- Respect the opinions of your classmates
- Be brief. If you write long responses, it's unlikely anyone will spend the time to read it all
- Don't use offensive language
- Stay on topic. Don't post irrelevant comments, links, thoughts, or pictures
- Contact your teacher in the event that you have any questions/issues
